Service Update from Our Envelope Company!

LETTER CONCEPTS

Please accept our sincere apology for the continuing envelope production issues we have experienced since the beginning of 2026. We would like to share with you the steps we have taken to address these challenges, along with encouraging news about our operations moving forward.

Some of the delays arose after one of our major vendors declared bankruptcy late last year, affecting our supply of envelopes. Since then, we have secured additional supplier partnerships to help ensure more consistent and timely production.

In addition, we have invested more than half a million dollars in a new production line to improve efficiency and quality. Work to repair equipment failures was delayed when parts being shipped from overseas were held up for weeks in customs, but we now have installed equipment, updated programming and are using cameras to assist in ensuring quality.

We know that these investments are assisting us as we move along the path to continued on-time production and delivery. We believe the changes we have made will allow us to return to timely delivery of our envelopes to all customers shortly, and definitely by midyear.

We appreciate your continued partnership and value the feedback you provide, which helps us improve our services. The next most important thing is loving others. God wants us to love and care for the people He has put into our lives. First we must care for our family that He has given us and then our friends and neighbours.

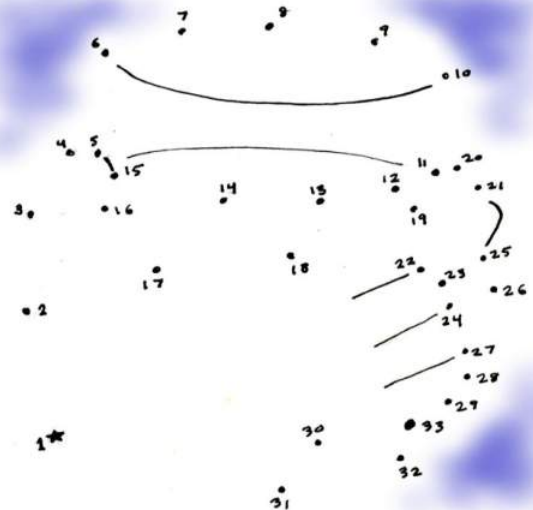
