I Believe I believe because every day I wait to hold eternity in my hand and I believe that something so small is so much greater, that something so flat has unknown dimensions, that something so light carries the weight of the world, that something that can be broken is indivisible, that something that can be eaten can't be disintegrate, that something I can manipulate is my Creator, and so I believe you are here with me forever hidden in the bread. This morning, like every morning I held eternity in my hand, then ate It, and tomorrow I will do the same. God has become constant and so believable.



The Body and Blood of Christ

Today we celebrate the feast day of the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. At the Last Supper, Jesus knew that He was going to leave His friends. So He turned the bread into His Body and the wine into His Blood - even though they still looked like bread and wine - and told the Apostles to do the same.

Jesus gave the Apostles, who were the first priests, the power to change bread and wine into His Body and Blood in the Mass. Now at every Mass Jesus comes to us on the altar, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity!

Of course we can't see any change happen when the priest consecrates the bread and wine, but we know that God can do things without us understanding them. He loves us so much that He wants to come to us hidden in Holy Communion. Now it is up to us to love Him back with our whole hearts!

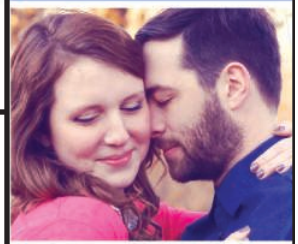
